



Dear Parents and Carers,

We are very excited to let you know that our homework in Maths is evolving. We are starting to use something called Flipped Learning. Flipped Learning is a strategy that enables your child to watch a short video that links to their Maths learning in school, but most importantly it teaches them a new skill that they can practise at home before they come to school on a Monday. This allows them to watch the video as many times as they need so when they come to apply the skill in school they should feel more confident and able to succeed. We are also excited that this approach will give parents the knowledge and strategies to support their child's learning.

As the videos contain spoken instruction, your child might like to bring in a simple, spare pair of earphones from home or they will be able to use school purchased ones that are shared with other children.

For children who have limited or no access to the internet, we will be ensuring they have time to use and learn from the video during Basic Skills sessions on Monday mornings, ready for their first Maths lesson of the week.

Before we set any Flipped Learning homework for the children we thought that you might like to have a go first!
