We are learning to...

- * enjoy both fiction and non-fiction books
- * write our names and form all letters correctly on whiteboards, paper, in sand, cornflour and on the ground with chalk, paintbrushes and water. (If your child can already write their name, it is very important that they form the letters correctly, starting from the correct place.)
- * segment short words into sounds
- * blend sounds together to read words
