

















Vocabulary	
Capital City	The capital of a country is the city or town where its government or parliament meets.
Seaside town	A town that is close to the sea.
Journey	To travel from one place to another
Popular	Something that is enjoyed or liked by a lot of people
Beach	A beach is an area of sand or stones beside the sea
Cliff	A cliff is a high area of land with a very steep side, especially one next to the sea.
Coast	An area of land that is next to the sea.
Sea	A large area of salty water that is part of an ocean.
Village	A village consists of a group of houses, together with other buildings such as a church and school. A small settlement in the countryside.
